- Purpose:
 - Ongoing feedback
 - Evidence
 - Recommendations
 - Reporting



<u>Indicators:</u> Specific/measurable, connected to evaluation questions, evidence of progress


Data Collection: Methods and sources

Analysis: Procedures to summarize data


<u>Interpretation:</u> Results compared to expected outcomes/evaluation question






Sample Evaluation Results – Citation Analysis







Sample Evaluation Results – Altmetric Analysis




Sample Evaluation Results – Altmetric Analysis






Sample Evaluation Results – Social Network Analysis


Social network between authors at program institutions and authors at external institutions


