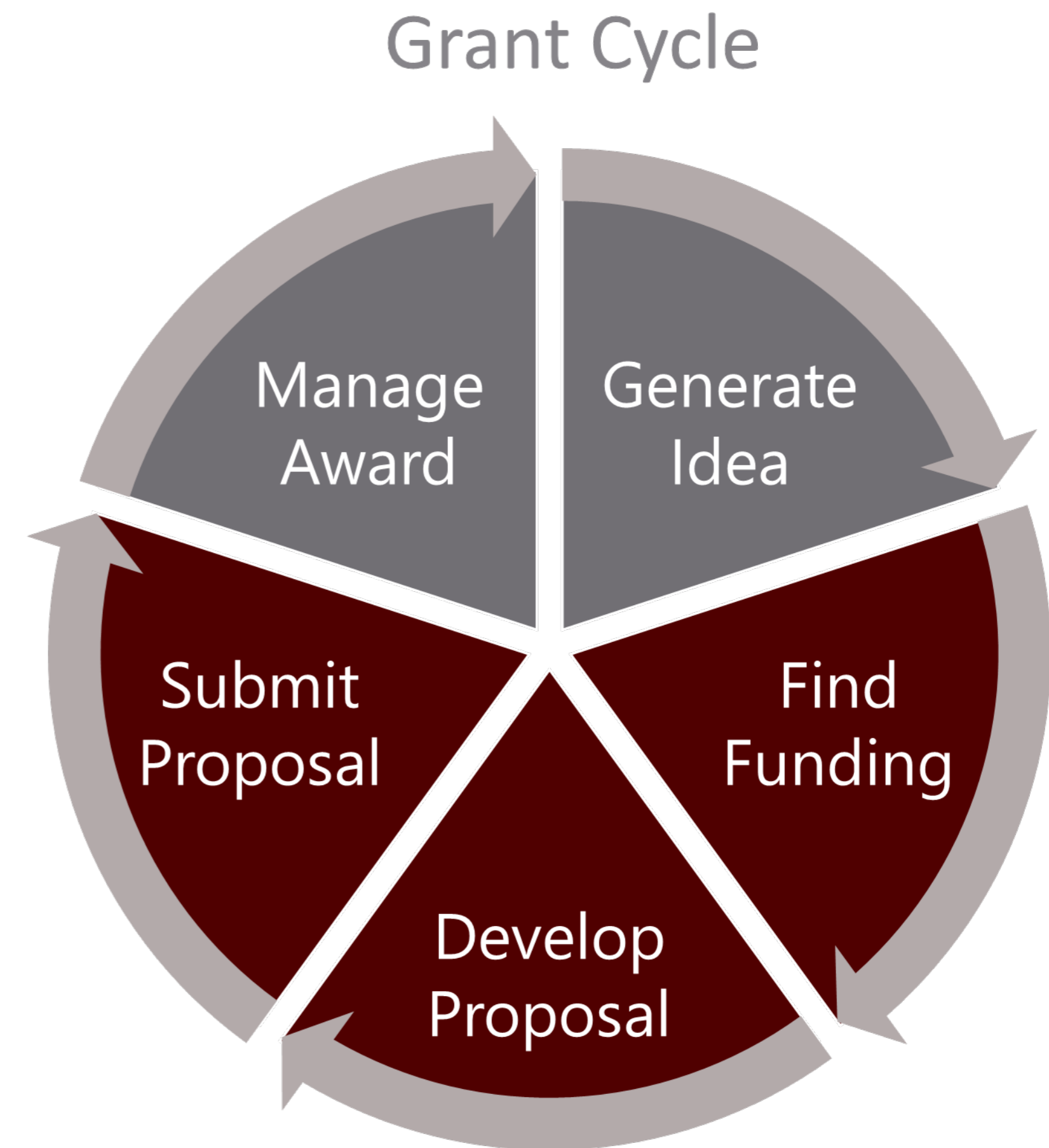

Guidelines for Submission

Exploring Funding Opportunities - Always check Eligibility!

- ✓ 1862 Land-Grant Institutions
- ✓ Public and state-controlled institutions of higher education
- ✓ State agricultural experiment stations
- ✓ Non-profit, associated with educational or research activities
- ⚠ Colleges and universities
- ⚠ Institutions of higher education OR degree granting institution
- ⚠ Is it a limited submission? Additional steps may be needed
 - ⚠ <https://vpr.tamu.edu/initiate-research/lsp> for list of proposals and how to apply
 - ⚠ Must be selected by limited submission process to move forward with submission

When in doubt, contact SRS to review, or ask the program officer for a determination in writing.

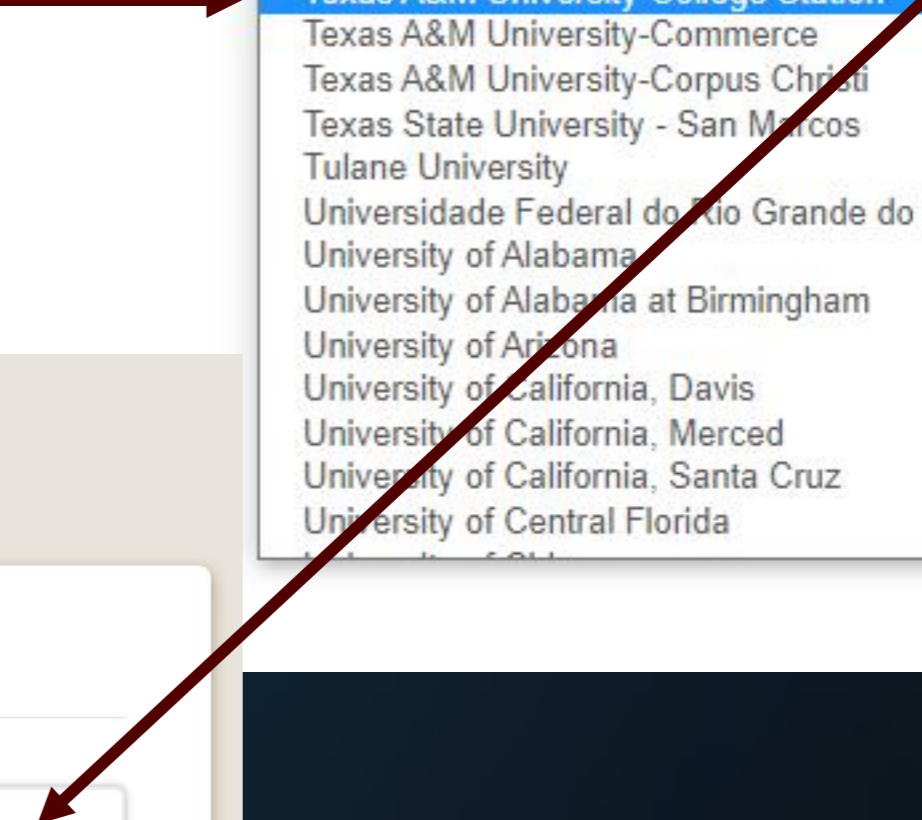

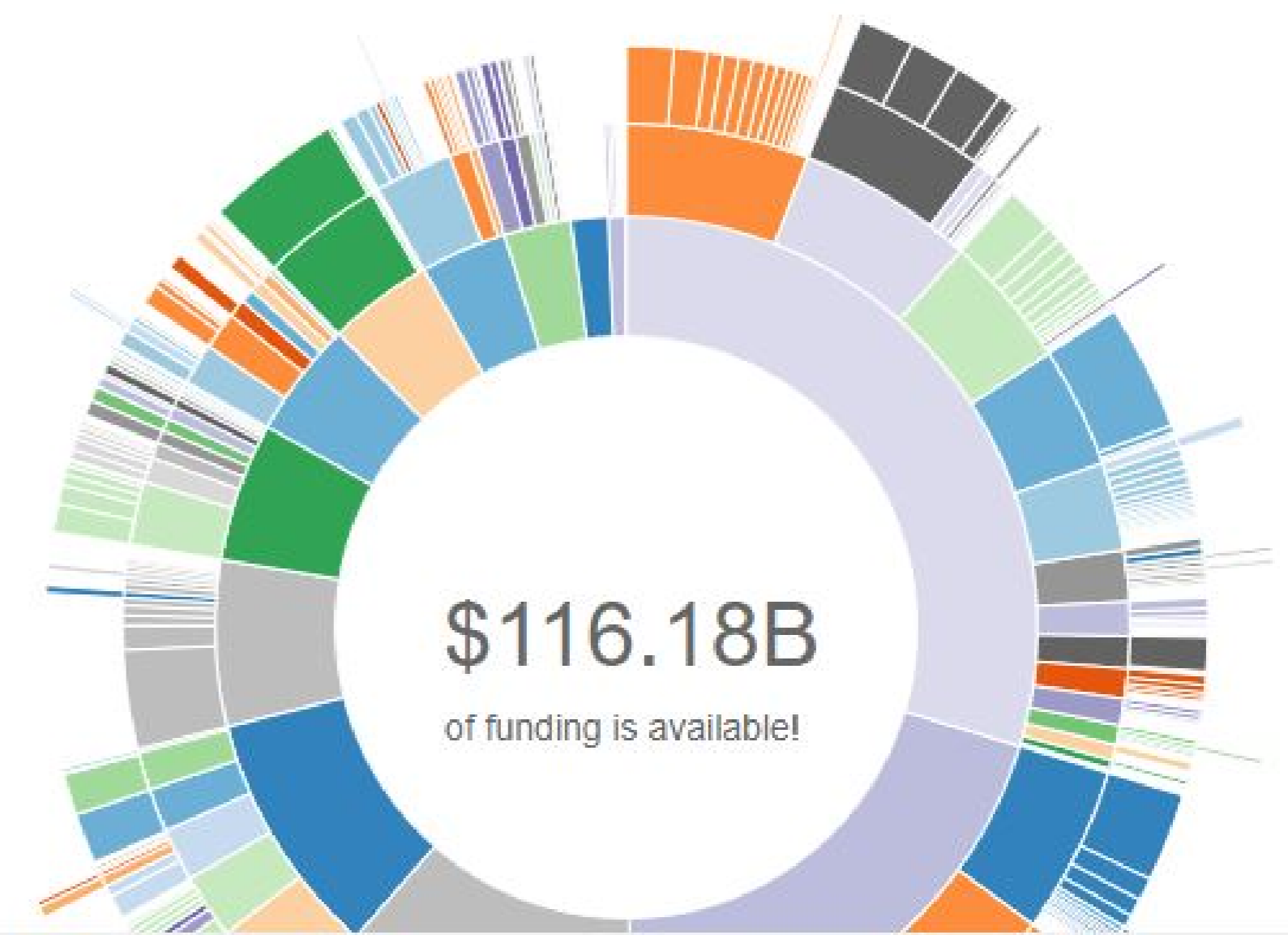

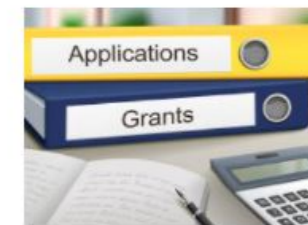

Exploring Funding Opportunities – Reading the RFA

1. Scan for Eligibility
2. Scan for Due Date
3. Scan for Budget Amount or Cost Share
4. Read the Purpose – Can you propose work that will respond to the sponsors needs?
5. Find type of agreement to be awarded
 1. Grant
 2. Cooperative Agreement
 3. Contract
6. All the above look good? Proceed to read the funding opportunity in DETAIL

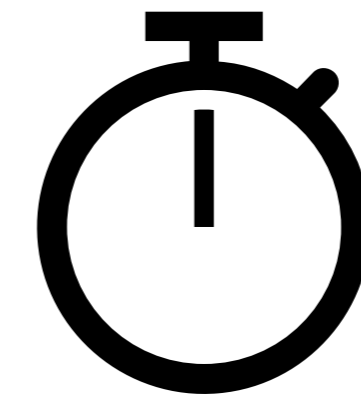

Ready to submit: Where do I start?

Determine what type of proposal you are submitting and notify the appropriate office.

- Sponsored Research Services submits competitive sponsored research proposals
- AgriLife Contracts Office handles non-sponsored gifts, contracts, and other agreements
 - Includes commodity sponsors, service agreements, and non-competitive industry sponsors
 - Non-Disclosure Agreements (NDA), Material Transfer Agreements (MTAs), and other agreement types.



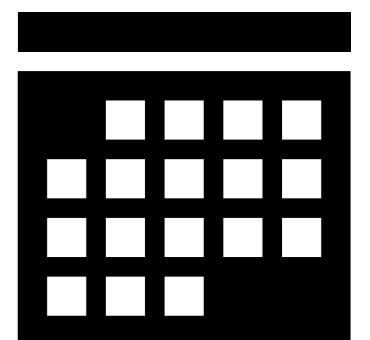

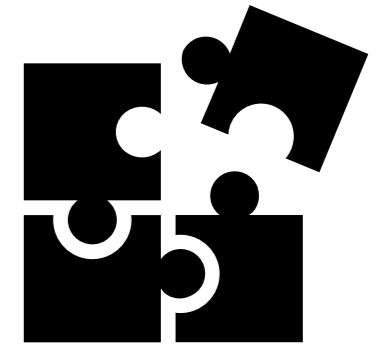

When should I utilize Corporate Engagement and Research Support?

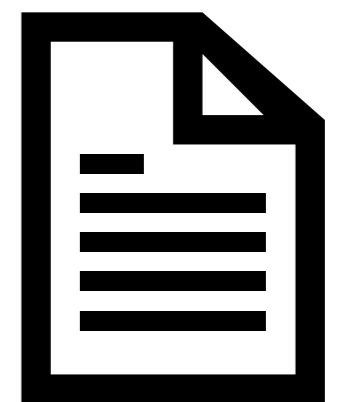
- Support is available for large multidisciplinary sponsored research proposal development alongside the services SRS provides
