Internship Responsibilities Include:

- Assisting park visitors with directions, park information, gift shop sales, and questions
- Cleaning and maintaining park facilities and trails
- Creating and presenting interpretive programs to park visitors
- Educating park visitors on park regulations
- □ Assisting with special projects (e.g. trail maintenance, visitor surveys, etc.)

Benefits: \$100/week stipend and free dormitory style housing.

Other: Work is performed in a remote setting with limited resources and conveniences. Interns must live on site in a two-bedroom, dormitory-style setting and will be required to work weekends and holidays.
