Venture Camp: Base Camp 2018

Position Description

POSITION FUNCTION

To facilitate a healthy transition and camp experience for all new undergraduate students during Venture Camp: Base Camp. There will be two Venture Mentors for Alpha and two Venture Mentors for Bravo.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

During preparation, Venture Mentors work most directly with the Student Development Specialist in Extended Orientation for program curriculum and small group facilitation. During Base Camp, Venture Mentors will support and take direction from the Extended Orientation and Outdoor Adventures staff members.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Participate in all meetings, trainings, and workshops associated with Base Camp during the semester and prior to program.
- Assist with the planning, implementation, and evaluation of Base Camp. Work productively and cooperatively with all members of the University community to effectively implement Extended Orientation programs.
- Provide leadership by leading a small group, facilitating group activities, and maintaining and following the Camp schedule.
- Organize, direct, and implement areas of responsibility assigned in an effective and efficient manner.
- Actively manage the risks of Base Camp activities.
- Monitor all assigned Base Camp activities/events.
- Assist with all public relations activities as necessary (Which could include answering questions via the internet, telephone, person-to-person, mailings) regarding Base Camp.
- Work cooperatively with others to perform necessary 'wrap-up' duties and transition materials after Base Camp.
- Coordinate after camp events in the fall semester following the program to support student transition as outlined by the professional staff.
- Understand and support the goals of Base Camp.
- Initiate and develop open communication and interaction with students attending camp.
- Serve as a positive role-model and ambassador on behalf of the Texas A&M University.
- Maintain a connection with participants upon return to campus throughout the academic year.
- Perform any additional duties as assigned by the professional staff for program success.

QUALIFICATIONS & STANDARDS (EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE)

- Be enrolled as a student at Texas A&M University at the time of selection, training, and in the fall following the Venture Camp: Base Camp program (this includes student on the Texas A&M Blinn Team)
- Applicants must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPR and have posted at least a 2.0 GPR for the semester prior to the application period (if applicable) to be eligible for selection.
- Venture Mentors must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPR and post a 2.0 GPR for the Spring 2018 semester while serving in this position.
- Venture Mentors may not be on academic, or conduct probation with the Office of Student Conduct or Aggie Honor System Office, at the time of application nor at any time throughout their position term through the Venture Camp: Base Camp program
- Applicants for the Venture Mentor position must submit a completed application and be available for all trainings and program dates.
- All applicants must schedule an appointment for an interview upon submission of their application in accordance with the process outlined below.

APPLICATION

INTERVIEW

Applicants will be contacted by Venture Camp: Base Camp Staff to set-up a 30 minute professional interview. Venture Mentor Interviews will be conducted the week of **Monday, November 27th, 2017.**

SELECTION

All candidates will be notified of Venture Mentor selections on or before Wednesday, December 6th at 5:00PM.

POSITION TERMINATION

A Venture Mentor's position may be terminated if it is determined that he/she is not maintaining ethics befitting a professional, not performing satisfactorily, not able to work productively with others, or jeopardizing the safety and success of the Venture Camp: Base Camp program. This leadership position is a volunteer position and supervision will be provided collectively between the professional staff members of the Extended Orientation Team and Outdoor Adventures for the success of the program.
