Starting pay is \$11.50/hr and the position is 35 hours per week. Summer camp runs June 10 – August 9<sup>th</sup>. Orientation and CPR certification takes place the week prior to the beginning of summer camp. This is primarily a day camp and runs Monday – Friday. There is one weekend camping trip where they would be scheduled to work at Cedar Hill State Park. Campers ages are from 5 – 16.

The positions support the outdoor adventures program which consists of mountain biking, archery, geocaching, fishing, nature photography, camping, and kayaking. Experience is not necessary as we have certified staff who will lead the activities. This is a support position. Light administrative duties as assigned. All work will primarily be outside with a variety of children. Our program serves approximately 1000 children per summer.
