The Opportunity:

This internship is a partnership with [Lyndon B. Johnson National Historical Park](#) and the [Texas Conservation Corps](#) and is focused on assisting the park staff with multiple facets of resource management and park preservation of cultural landscapes. The intern(s) will work alongside the park's ranching crew/resource management team and the work will include:

- Assisting with managing the LBJ Ranch's historic herd of registered Hereford cattle.
 - This will include daily feeding of livestock, routine care and training of livestock, and annual inventory for entire herd.
- Assisting NPS staff with resource management projects and the treatment of invasive species on the park properties such as mesquite, cactus, thistles, etc.
- Assisting NPS staff to repair and maintain historic fences, gates, and pens on the historic LBJ Ranch.
- Assisting NPS staff with hazard fuels reduction and repairing of the cultural landscape within the LBJ Ranch.

The Requirements:

- 18 – 30 years of age.
- Possess a valid driver's license.
- Be able to complete a minimum of 300 hours (8 weeks) of work to fulfill internship hours.
 - If available, internship may be extended to 640 hours of work (16 weeks).

The Benefits:

- \$1300/mo (direct deposit)
- \$1200 Education Award to pay for student loans
- Housing may be available (free of charge)
- Gain experience working in the National Park Service.
- Earn volunteer hours and possibly receiving college credit hours.
- Possibly earn PUBLIC LANDS CORPS (PLC) Hiring Authority for federal employment
