CALL FOR POSTER SESSION ABSTRACTS

Accepting abstract submissions until April 3, 2020

We are accepting abstract submissions for the 2020 Southern Pasture Forage Crop Improvement Conference in Montgomery, AL, April 28 – April 30.

Abstracts should be submitted to Dr. Rocky Lemus (Rocky.Lemus@msstate.edu) by Friday April 3, 2020 at 5:00 P.M. CT

GUIDELINES

ABSTRACT:

- 1. Abstracts should be between 300-350 words.
- Abstract should include title (Bold, Times Roman 14); authors (Times Roman 12), author's affiliations (Times Roman 12), rationale (one or two sentences); objectives (one or two sentences); materials and methods; brief results; implications (see attached example).
- 3. Use English units in text, tables, and figures.
- 4. Center the title, authors, abstract heading, and table titles.
- 5. Use a zero placeholder to the left of decimal points (0.05, not .05) in text, tables, and figures.
- 6. Add contact email for the leading author.

POSTER:

1. Posters should be 3 ½ feet (40 inches) wide and 2 ½ feet (30 inches) tall.

 Posters will be displayed in the afternoon of *April 28, 2020*; therefore, they should be posted between 1:00 PM and 5:00 PM. Poster viewing with authors present is from 6:00 pm to 6:30 pm.

BLITZ PRESENTATION:

If you would like to present a 5-minute blitz presentation during the general session that will complement your poster, please email your abstract to Dr. Leanne Dillard (dillasa@auburn.edu) in addition to following the previous instructions by *April 3, 2020*. You will be notified if you are selected to participate by *April 10, 2020*. No more than six participants will be selected for this session. If you are selected, you must submit your final slide set as a PowerPoint file no later than *April 24, 2019* to Dr. Dillard at dillasa@auburn.edu. Slides will be automatically advanced every 15 seconds during this 5-minute presentation (20 slides total including the introductory slide). Participants will not be able to advance slides or use a laser pointer. Questions will be held until the subsequent poster session.
