Frequently Asked Questions

Who can teach the Texas AgrLife Extension Ambassador Program?

Any teacher who attended a Texas Friendly Ambassador Hospitality Program training session and has registered with our office.

What will we teach?

The hospitality curriculum covers 5 core areas: C.I.V.I.L Framework, Culture & Community, Netiquette+, Making a Good Impression, and Putting Into Practice. All materials will be provided via CD.

What will be on the CD?

Curriculum materials on the CD will include 15 lesson plans (3 for each topic area), 15 Power-Point presentation, 15 lesson guides, various activities/assignments and additional instructor resources (extended PowerPoint, additional resources, and additional readings).

How do we get access to materials?

All teachers who attended a Texas Friendly Ambassador Program training session must register with the Ambassador Program in order to receive teaching materials.

What happens after program training?
