





### **How to Apply**



Check with the Extension Office to see if your camp qualifies.

To verify that a youth's chosen camp is eligible for a scholarship, youth should check with the 4-H Department before registering for a camp at tarrant4-h@ag.tamu.edu.



Notify 4-H Agent via e-mail that you intend to apply for the scholarship at tarrant4-H@ag.tamu.edu



3 Register and pay for the approved camp or event. Youth must be approved and active member of a Tarrant County 4-H club at the time of registration.



4 Attend the camp in its entirety!



5 Submit essay to the 4-H Department about what you learned at camp and all your great experiences

This essay is due via e-mail no later than 30 days after the camp end date to tarrant4-h@ag.tamu.edu.



Full or partial scholarship will be issued as a reimbursement

Scholarships will only pay for the registration cost for youth member attending

Amount of scholarship available will be based on number of youth attending and will only be determined after registration for camp closes

JOANN Fabric & Craft is helping 4-H bring more hands-on programs to local communities across the nation to inspire kids to lead lives with their hearts, hands, and minds. The Clovers for Kids campaign monies are now available to Texas 4-H clubs, project groups, and county 4-H programs through a mini-grant program. Mini-grants are designed to help build and support 4-H Fashion and Interior Design project work. This year we are excited to announce that we will be increasing the number of grants to be awarded AND an increase in the amount of the grants. This year we will offer (6) \$500 mini-grants and (12) \$250 mini-grants.

### **Guidelines for applying:**

- Application must be for the support of a 4-H Club, group, or service project in Texas.
- Funds must be used for building or supporting a 4-H Fashion and Interior Design project.

#### **Examples of such include:**

- Purchasing equipment and/or supplies for a community service project
- Purchasing supplies for a Fashion & Interior Design workshop
- Pay for group tour expenses
- Purchase sewing machines for county program
- Funds cannot be used for: Personal gain or use
