- 2) Grooming- make sure your animal's coat is conditioned and appropriately clipped
- 3) Show Box/Trailer Organization- go through and check for proper supplies and tools needed to care for, prepare and show your animal
- 4) Know your Animal- make sure to know your animal's stats for any questions you may get asked by the judge
- **5) Know your schedule** make sure you know check-in/weigh-in and show time as well as all rules associated with your species
- 6) Show Time- take a deep breath and be confident in your hard work you have put in to get
