Shavings and barn dust, here we come. Here are a few tips provided by the NRS and Arena Ranch Store in Decatur, TX as we prepare.

- 1) <u>Nutrition</u> monitoring your animal to make sure it is healthy and eating a balanced diet.
- **2)** <u>Grooming</u> make sure your animal's coat is conditioned and appropriately clipped.
- **3)** Know Your Animal make sure to know your animal's stats for any questions you may get asked by the judge.
- **4)** Show Box/Trailer Organization go through and check for proper supplies and tools needed to care for, prepare and show your animal.
- **5)** Know Your Schedule make sure you know check-in/weigh-in and show time as well as rules associated with your species.
- **6)** <u>Show Time</u> take a deep breath and be confident in your hared work you have put in to get where you are.
