2019 Cropping Season Complete

The 2019 row cropping season has slowly come to an end with mixed results. After a very wet spring resulting in later planting dates for corn and grain sorghum, the weather turned off incredibly dry. Some areas of the county didn't receive ANY measurable rainfall for 60+ days. Therefore, harvest reflected the dryness in certain areas of the county. Corn yields averaged around 100 bushels and grain sorghum approximately 5000 lbs/acre. Cotton yields that were planted early fared better

than the later plantings. The county cotton average was approximately 2-2.5 bales/acre. Soybeans averaged 30 bushels/acre. After baling a large cutting of hay in the first cutting, folks are still hoping to get a second one before the first frost. Fortunately, hay surplus this year will help feed cattle this

winter. Cattle numbers and pricing have remained steady to strong throughout the year. Demand continues to be strong in foreign markets and cattle numbers are still climbing in Texas. May the rain hit the areas that you need this fall and winter. All the best and God continue to richly bless each of you.
