

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

The average American owns 6 pairs of jeans and 10 pieces of denim

Nearly 12 million tons of textile waste were sent to landfills in 2014."

Approximately 1,677 pieces of denim will divert roughly one ton of waste from a landfill

Denim made from cotton, a natural fiber, can be recycled into insulation.

## MAKING A DIFFERENCE THROUGH RECYCLING

Created in 2006, the Blue Jeans Go Green™ program collects denim to divert it from landfills and partners with Bonded Logic, Inc. to recycle it into UltraTouch™ Denim Insulation. Each year, a portion of the insulation is distributed to help with building efforts across the country, often in areas affected by natural disasters.
