2022-2023 4-H Enrollment

Enrollment for the new year will begin on August 15th for 4th-12th graders and on September 1st for all 3rd graders.

NEW this year for Livestock Tag-Ins: Hair will be pulled on commercial heifers, steers, lambs, goats and swine at tag-in and stored with a third party company until after the County Fair (Rule #2 in the general livestock rules).

The hairs will be pulled, placed in an envelope and sealed. At this time, the exhibitor, parent/guardian, AST/4-H leader and the technician will sign the envelope validating the hair sample inside. This being the case, exhibitors, parents/guardians, AST and 4-H leaders will need to be with the animals at tag-in.

If the parent/guardian is unable to attend tag-in, they may check the box on the entry form and authorize another adult to sign on their behalf.
